- 2) **Apologies for absence:** None received.
- 3) **Minutes of the meeting held on 15 March 2011** - Not available
- 4) **Matters Arising** – The League had received Chartered Standard and Kath thanked Steph Knott for her help in making this possible.
- 5) **Womens and Girls Development Officer** – Stephanie Knott

- 6) **Staffordshire FA** – The development officer and league fixtures coordinator came to talk to the league about running a cross county cup as there were only 4 teams in their league. All of the members agreed that it was a good idea and the Staffordshire league would look at fitting in their fixtures.
- 7) **Secretary's Report** – Kath had issued the League Admin rules to all secretaries. The team details/secretary details were given out for checking please advise if any numbers are not correct including kit colours.

Change to where the fixtures will be located. These will now be at the back of the Baths. There will also be a spare notice board if any one has any posters, information that they would like to display for teams.

There are now numbered buckets in the barn for small sided pitches, where you will take a net from the bucket of the pitch you are playing on. Please put nets back in the correct buckets.

- 8) **Correspondence** – After the consultation about allowing mixed football to U13's this has now been passed by the FA and the rules changed from the beginning of this season.
