

Player Registrations

New Players

- 1) The completed registration form must be signed by a) the parent or guardian of the child and b) the Club secretary.
- 2) If the child's surname is different than the parent or guardian's name, the form must be accompanied by a letter explaining the reason for this.
- 3) The form must be accompanied with **a copy** (not an original) of the child's birth certificate.
- 4) The form must be accompanied by **TWO** recent passport style photographs of the child. School photographs or digital photographs **will not** be accepted. The photograph must be a full face view and the child must not be wearing a hat unless there is a genuine medical reason.

Current or previous players in the Cheshire Girls' League

- 1) The completed registration form must be signed by a) the parent or guardian of the child and b) the Club secretary.
- 2) The form **must be accompanied** by the previous season's (2008/09) Player ID card.
- 3) The form must be accompanied by **TWO NEW** passport style photographs.
- 4) Another copy of the birth certificate is not necessary if they have played in the League in 2008/09 season. If they played prior to that but not last season, they will need to provide another copy of the birth certificate.
- 5) If they have played for another club in the previous season please try to contact that club and ask the secretary to send you the 08/09 ID card for that player so that it can accompany the registration form for the coming season. (This will help to make registration run more smoothly).

Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the application for registration being rejected. If you are only submitting the minimum number of registrations per age group on registrations day, rejected applications could result in failure to secure your team's place in the League!
